All entries will be judged as singles. 3. The exhibitor must own all birds for at least 30 days. 4. All birds must be penned between 5:00 pm and 9:00 pm Thursday, August 24th, 2023. 5. All birds will be fed and watered. (With layer pellets/waterfowl crumble. If special food is required, it must be provided) 6. All birds must be free of lice and mites. No diseased bird will be accepted. 7. All entries to be judged by American Standard of Perfection. Game bird do not require dubbing. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 8. Judging to take place August 25, starting at 8:00 am 9. No poultry is to be removed before Sunday, August 27 at 5:00 pm 10. Entries may be limited by space available 11. No late entries will be accepted. 12. All entries must include entry fee. 13. Birds are allowed to be sold (a section will be available for “For Sale Only”) No animals will be allowed to be removed until 5:00 pm Sunday. If you plan to sell non show birds, please let the chairperson know. (Space is limited.)
